

Visitors in my home policy

As an Ofsted registered childminder I am very aware of my role in keeping your child safe. Whilst it is important that children are given the opportunity to mix with other adults and children it is my responsibility to ensure the suitability of those that they come into contact with during their time with me.

- All visitors will be asked to sign my visitor's book which is available for you to look at, it is situated on the kitchen noticeboard.
- Where ever possible I will organise any maintenance work on the property to take place outside of minding hours.
- I will not leave minded children alone with a visitor, unless I know they have been DBS (CRB) cleared.

We do have family who live further afield; there will be occasion that they will be visiting us. This will mean that they will also be in the house when minded children are here. Through their jobs and volunteer roles the majority of our family members are DBS checked. All parents whose children I will be minding during these visits will be informed that they are happening. They will of course not affect the care or routines of the children at all.
